77th Annual One Design Regatta August 13-14, 2016 Fishing Bay Yacht Club Deltaville, Virginia



1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Annual One Design regatta is open to the following invited classes Flying Scot, Front Runner, Lasers (Full and Radial), Optimist Dinghy (Red, Blue, White and Green fleets). Other classes may be added at the discretion of the Event Coordinator.
- 2.2 Classes with 7 or more boats registered by end of day Monday, August 8 will be given individual starts.
- 2.3 Classes not meeting the 7 boat minimum required for an individual start will be started with similarly situated classes in a Portsmouth Handicap fleet.
- 2.4 Additional classes may be added at the discretion of FBYC.
- 2.5 Each competitor will be responsible for their boats being in compliance with class rules.
- 2.6 All pre-registered competitors are required to check-in at the check-in table upon their arrival at the club not later than 0925 on the first day of the regatta.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Entries received on or before end of day Monday, August 8 will receive a \$25 discount.
- 3.2 Entries include entry for 1 boat, up to two dinners per boat, a regatta souvenir and all drinks saturday evening.

3.3 Entry fees:

Singlehanded Junior: \$90 (\$65 by 8/8) Singlehanded Adult: \$100 (\$75 by 8/8) Doublehanded Adult: \$130 (\$105 by 8/8)

3.4 Additional adult and junior meals (drinks included) can be pre-purchased before 8/8 for \$20 and \$12. Additional meals for non-competitors may not be available for purchase after 8/8 and at additional cost.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing instructions will be posted online by the morning of the regatta and available at check-in.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The racing areas for adult classes will be on the Piankatank River between Fishing Bay and Godfrey Bay on the North and South and Gwynn's island to the east.
- 6.2 The racing areas for junior classes will be in Fishing Bay.
- 6.3 Hand-launched boats may use ample ramp and beach facilities. Trailered boats will be put in by tractor or may use the hoist on the North side of the property in Jackson Creek.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The Low-point scoring system will be used as defined in Appendix A.
- 7.2 No races will be excluded.

8 AWARDS

8.1 Awards will be given to the first 3 finishers in each class.

8.2 The John R. Hawksworth Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the class winner who has been most competitive as measured both by the degree to which he has consistently been at the top of his class and the number of boats against which he has competed.

14 DIRECTIONS

14.1 Deltaville is on the western shore of the Chesapeake Bay and is approached via US 17 and US 33 regardless of whether you drive on I-95 from the north or I-95 and I-64 from the south. At Saluda continue east on US 33 to Deltaville and turn right at the 7-11 on Route 1102, Fishing Bay Road, and follow the signs until you see Fishing Bay immediately in front of you at the "End of State Maintenance." Turn left and continue slowly for some 0.40 mile over multiple speed bumps until you see the FBYC dry sail area and hoist on your left.
