How to get there:

From Northern Virginia: Go south on I-95 then east on US-17 at Fredricksburg to Saluda, Go east on Rt. 33 about 15 mi. to Deltaville, right at Little Sue/Exxon.....

From West or South take I-64 East to Route 33 through West Point, Glens and Saluda to Deltaville, right at Little Sue/Exxon.....

From Hampton Roads take I-64 to US 17 to Gloucester, turn right on Rt. 3 to Hartfield then Rt. 33 to Deltaville, Right at Little Sue....

From Little Sue/Exxon: Follow Fishing Bay Road to water, bear left. Follow Stove Point Road to Yacht Club. Abide by 15 mph speed limit on Stove Point Road (private road)

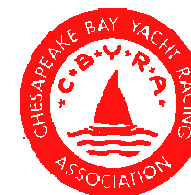
